# May we remind you...

#### <u>Drinks</u>

The children have access to drinking water at all times at Nursery and are offered a choice of milk or water at snack time. Additionally the children may bring their own drinks bottle from home. Please could we ask that bottles are named. We also ask that fizzy drinks and energy drinks are not provided.

#### Fee Paying Families

We offer an online transfer option to pay Nursery fees. If you would like to use this service please pop into the Nursery office where we will be able to provide you with the appropriate bank details.

#### <u>Keeping the Children Safe in the Sun</u>

With the continuing beautiful weather may we remind you that we expect all children have sun cream applied **before** they arrive at Nursery. Nursery staff will re-apply sun cream throughout the day as necessary. Please ensure that the children's shoulders are covered to protect their sensitive skin.

#### Late Collection

We understand that there could be rare occasions when you may be late to collect your child due to circumstances beyond your control. However, it is our expectation that you will contact us to inform us of this or any alternative arrangements made. Unfortunately, late collection of children has a cost implication for the Nursery due to changing staffing levels for the different sessions and it is therefore necessarv to charge parents/carers £5 for every fifteen minutes that the child remains in our care outside their session times.



#### Woods

Children who attend Nursery on a Monday afternoon in The Coral Reef and The Deep Blue Sea will all spend time in the woods every Monday afternoon for the Autumn Term. Don't worry if your child does not come to Nursery at this time as we change the day and time of these sessions on a termly basis so that as many children as possible have access to this experience during the academic year. The first session will be on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September.

We provide an all-in-one, padded suit for the children to wear in the woods in the cooler weather to keep them warm and protect their clothing. They will need to wear hats and gloves on cold days as we go out in all weathers; the only exception is windy conditions. In warmer weather we ask that you send your child to Nursery in clothing that covers their legs, such as trousers or leggings. We have a very small supply of wellies; please send a pair of named wellies for your child to wear if possible for this session. If anyone has any old wellies your child has outgrown that you would be happy to donate to Nursery we would be extremely grateful.

Kerry Whincop leads the woods sessions; she already holds a Level 1 qualification in Forest Schools and is hoping to begin her Level 2 training in the Spring. The children have the opportunity to get involved in many different activities such as den building, mud painting and using tools. We have a fire most weeks and the children quickly learn rules about keeping safe. We have found the impact of these sessions on the children's development to be extremely positive with particular benefits to their Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Communication and Language skills. If you have any questions or concerns please speak to Hayley or Kerry Whincop.

#### Books

Please feel free to borrow books from the Nursery to share with your child. We ask that you borrow one book at a time and bring it back when you have finished with it. The benefits of reading with babies and young children are enormous and have an extremely positive effect on their communication, language and literacy development. 'Storytelling and reading activities can help develop language and literacy skills by supporting competence in communicating, speaking and listening, being read to and beginning to read and write.' (Bookstart).

# How Children Learn and How Babies Learn Courses
