CELEBRATING SUCCESS AND PROMOTION OF CLUBS

PARKING

Parents and Taxis who park outside the school are asked to ensure they park legally, and with due consideration to the owners of neighbouring properties and the safety of pedestrians and other road users. Please remember we need access to the school and nursery at all times including weekends.

PHONICS SCREENING CHECK—YEAR 1/2

Please be advised that the Phonics Screening Check for all Year 1 and some Year 2 pupils will be carried out during week commencing 12th June. It is very important that all those pupils are in School during this week and do not miss this screening check. Thank you.

SCOOTERS

To ensure the safety of all, please ensure children do not use their scooters on the School paths. They should walk their scooter to and from the scooter rack. Thank you.

SAFEGUARDING—E-SAFETY

Please remember that computer games, DVD's and social media sites such as facebook have age restrictions in place. These are to protect your children from inappropriate images such as violence and bad language. Please can we remind parents of their responsibility to ensure they adhere to given age restrictions.

ILLNESS

Please telephone if your child is ill or is late. Being late often upsets children as they have to catch up on what has been taught. If a child is frequently late by 10 minutes then they will miss the equivalent of a lesson a week.

E-CIGARETTES

Please can I remind you that the use of e-cigarettes is not permitted anywhere on the school grounds.

HOLIDAYS

Please can we remind you requests for holidays in term time will not be authorised. A holiday form must be completed before you take your child out of school and these are available from your child's class teacher and reception.

STOMACH BUGS

Can we please remind you that if your child becomes ill with sickness and/or diarrhoea they must remain at home for 48 hours after the last bout of either vomiting or diarrhoea. This is to prevent the spread of this illness amongst other children in the school.
