<u>Homework</u>

Maths Homework: Maths Whizz! - Information to follow.

<u>Maths</u>

This half term the children will learn to recognise the value of each digit in numbers to 100. We will also be using a number line to record addition calculations. The majority of our Maths work will involve recognising and understanding the number system.

Computing

We are lucky to be able to use the Junior School's Computing suite every Wednesday. This half term we are focussing on using the internet safely and using simple programmes such as Textease. The children are learning how to save and retrieve their own files.

<u>English</u>

The children will have separate guided reading and phonics/spelling sessions. In their main English lesson they will apply their reading and writing skills.

This term we will be looking at various texts with a Seaside theme, including 'The Lighthouse Keepers lunch' and 'Lost and Found'. We will also be writing about the events that surrounded The Great Fire of London and learning to recount it using storytelling techniques.

<u>Spelling</u>

We look at one spelling rule per week and your child's Homework will revisit this rule to help secure their knowledge. We will begin by learning to spell the days of the week.



<u>Topic</u>

Our topics this half term will be the Great Fire of London and the Seaside. We will be studying a key local figure, Henry Blogg and how the seaside has changed.

In History we will be learning about The Great Fire of London. The children will learn about the events that surrounded it and about key individuals such as Samuel Pepys.

In art the children will create their own collage of the Great Fire of London using different materials
