FREE SCHOOL MEALS and PUPIL PREMIUM

All children are entitled to free school meals. However, if you are in receipt of benefits then please ask the office to give you a pupil premium form. By filling this in, the school will receive extra money which will be spent on enrichment activities for the children - for example Sheringham little theatre visit, hire of busses to go to Dinosaur Adventure etc. It is also used to bring additional support to your child in the classroom.

Your child will also be entitled to free milk every day. You do have to fill out an extra form for this but the office can help you. If you need help in filling in the forms please contact the office - any applications will be treated in the strictest confidence.
