A Message From the Nursery Team...

We are having an extremely exciting and busy Summer Term so far. As many of you will know, Seaview Pre-School closed suddenly earlier in the year leaving many families without much needed childcare and education for their children. As a result, and with the support of the county early years team we have been able to increase our occupancy, as well as enhancing the quality of our existing nursery provision. This has ensured that children, many of whom start school this September have access to a Nursery place during this crucial term and of course, beyond for the younger children.

We would like to extend a very warm welcome to all the families joining us this term and say a huge thank you to our existing families for being so patient and understanding during this period of change for the Nursery. We have been extremely fortunate to be able to appoint six excellent Nursery Assistants to join our team who have already developed lovely relationships with the children and are settling in well.

The most significant changes are that we now have sixteen 2 year old places available in The Coral Reef (increasing from twelve) and an additional fifteen 3-4 year old places. We have reduced the number of 3-4 years olds in The Deep Blue Sea from forty to thirty-two and opened 'The Lagoon' downstairs with space for up to twenty-three 3-4 year olds. Children going to school in September are spending their time between The Deep Blue Sea and The Lagoon, we have worked hard to consider friendships, time with the Key Person and the unique needs of each of the children- please do continue to speak to Hayley if you have any worries at all.

We continue to feel incredibly fortunate to work with your amazing children! There are lots of exciting events happening this term at Nursery and we hope you will be able to join us for them!





In recognition of Father's Day we would like to invite any Dad, Step-Dad, Grandad, Uncle, Brother, Neighbour or Friend of our children to the Nursery for a session in our on-site woodland! You will take part in different superhero-themed activities and have a special snack around the fire.

Nursery Sessions

We are busy making plans for the next academic year and places are filling fast! If you are planning to amend/increase your child's sessions please come into the office to speak to Hayley or Kathryn as soon as possible- we will do our best to help you.

Families where both parents (parent in single parent families) are working a minimum of 16 hours each week will be entitled to 30 hours (term time) or 23.75 hours (all year round) funded childcare from the term after their child turns 3 years old. If you would like information about how to apply please visit the 'Childcare Choices' website or speak to Hayley or Kathryn.





Sun Safety

We are hoping the sun makes an appearance very soon and would like your help to ensure that we are prepared when it does so!

We work hard to promote sun safety at Nursery with the children and many of them are able to tell us what they need to do in order to keep safe. We would appreciate you support with this.

Sun Cream

Please can we remind you that it is our expectation that parents/carers will apply sun cream to their child's skin before their Nursery session; staff will reapply sun cream as necessary throughout the day. We will use the Nursery 8 hour protection sun cream unless you advise us that your child needs to use their own due to an allergy or skin sensitivity.

Sun Hats

All children will have to wear a sunhat whilst outside at Nursery in order to remain safe in the sun (please send a named hat).

Shoulders

Please ensure that your child's shoulders are covered to reduce exposure and harm to their sensitive skin. Shoes

Please could we ask that children wear closed toe shoes at Nursery rather than sandals. This is to avoid injury particularly when they are taking part in activities such as riding bikes and building with our large wooden blocks. Additionally we will be using the woods more frequently and it is essential that shoes are worn in this environment.

Drinks

We always encourage the children to drink during their Nursery sessions but this becomes even more important during the warmer weather when young children are more vulnerable to the effects of dehydration. The children have access to drinking water at all times at Nursery and are offered a choice of milk or water at snack time. Additionally, the children may bring their own drinks bottle from home. Please could we ask that bottles are named. We also ask that fizzy drinks and energy drinks are not provided.





Nursery Communication

We know that the Nursery can feel incredibly busy at the beginning and end of the children's sessions but please do speak to a member of staff if you have any worries or concerns- we will always arrange a time to talk to you.

Please ensure that you inform us of any changes to your mobile telephone numbers as we do send texts on a regular basis.

Look out for information shared on Tapestry- all parents who have set up a Tapestry account will also be linked to 'Suffield Park Nursery Information' and you may receive reminders/updates via this means.
