

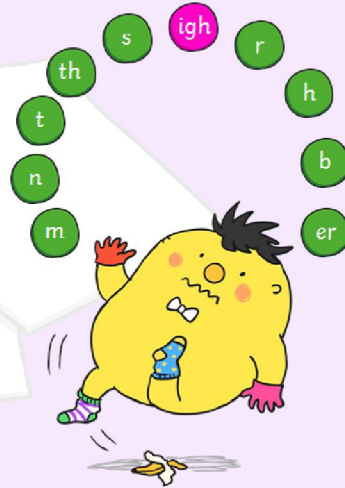
Phonics Activities.

How many real words can you make?

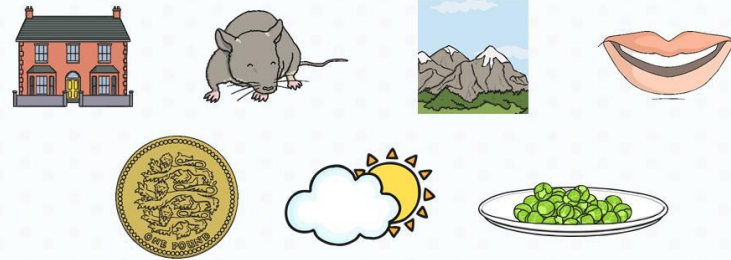


These words use ou:

Can you write a word containing each phoneme?

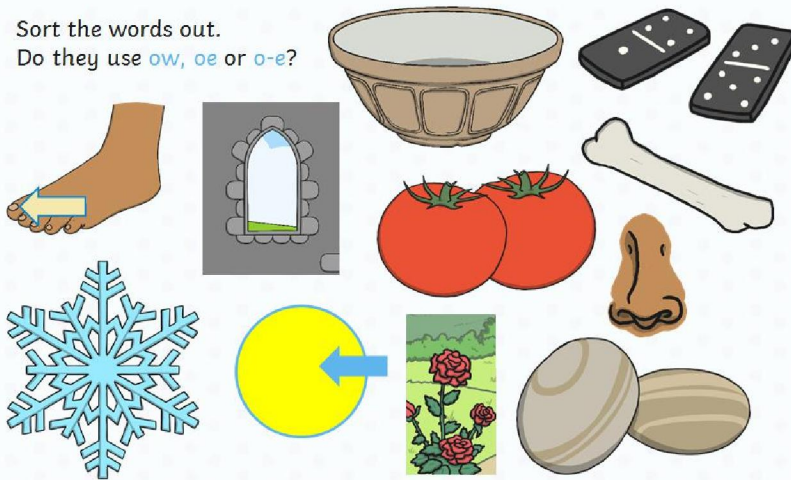


Extension: Choose one of the phonemes. How many more words can you find using this phoneme? Can you make up some nonsense words too?

Oe, o-e or ow?

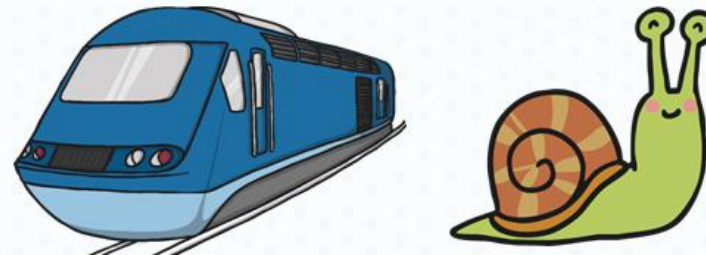
Sort the words out.

Can you spot the **ay**, **ai** and **a-e** words in this story?

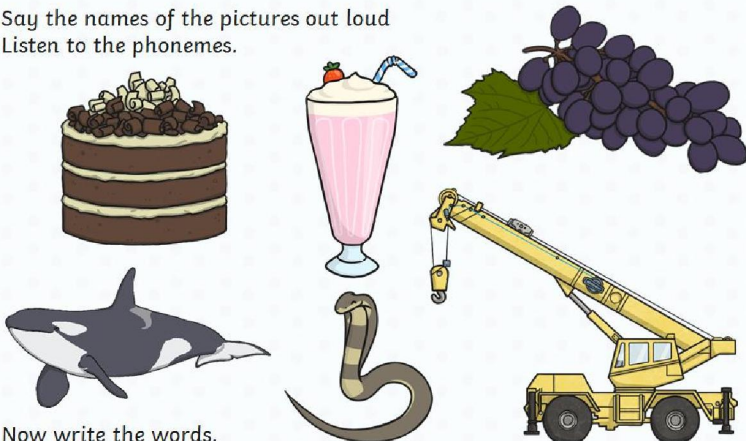

Listen to the phonemes.

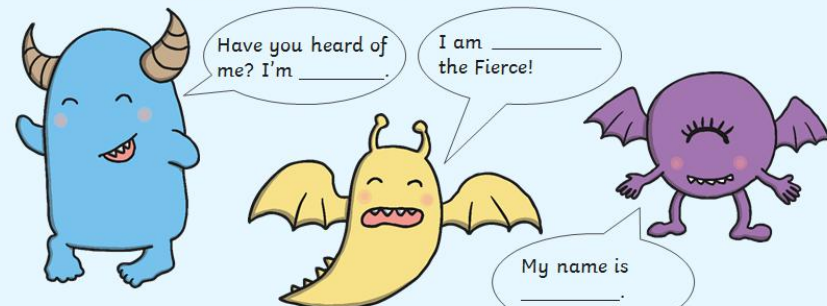


Now write the words.
