With the weather turning warmer, please don't forget to send your child with a named water bottle every day, apply sunscreen before their session, and make sure that they have a sunhat with them. Of course our weather can never be guaranteed, so make sure they have a raincoat and "closed toe" shoes at all times as the children are busy playing outside and in the woods, a named change of clothing is always useful too as many activities involve water.

Living with Covid-19 - As of the 1st April 2022 the guidance is, if a child has a positive test they will be advised to stay home for at least 3 days and return to nursery as long as they do not have a temperature and they are well enough to do so. If your child has symptoms of a respiratory infection - runny nose, sore throat or slight cough, they can attend Nursery if they are well enough to do so.

If your child has a high temperature (over 37.8.c) please keep them home until they are better and do not require any pain relief. Our standard policy is that children must stay off Nursery if any paracetamol or ibuprofen has been administered that day.

V&D - Can we remind you that with any bouts of vomiting or diarrhea that you keep your child home for 48 hours after the last episode.

Chickenpox - If your child has chickenpox (small watery blisters) please keep home until <u>ALL</u> of the spots have completely dried/scabbed.

We always welcome your feedback and will be sending a Parent Survey to get your views and suggestions about the Nursery. We constantly strive to do better and we appreciate your thoughts. Keep your eyes out for a Google form that will be sent on Tapestry shortly.
